Luc Geoffroy has been appointed Managing Director of Euro Media France, taking over from Louis Zumelzu who is currently on secondment in the Group. His main work is to provide the operational and organisational management of the group, in close cooperation with Bernard Chaussegros, Chairman of Euro Media France, who will supervise in particular the general development of the business, financial aspects and strategy.

Aged 55 and of Belgian nationality, Luc Geoffroy has an engineering degree from the Institut des Arts de Diffusion in Brussels. He studied electromechanical and electronic engineering.

He began his career in 1979 as a sound engineer at RTL TVI in Belgium, and created Euro Media Télévision in 1983, together with Jean-Pierre and Chantal Barry. He then held the position of technical director. He became COO of SFP in 2001, following its privatisation. Since 2007, he has worked as Chief Technical Officer of the Euro Media Group.

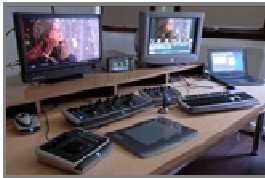
